The children will be completing different sports events all based on the track – these will include running, jumping and throwing events. The events will all be individual events and the children will receive stickers for their races. You are welcome to join us for the afternoon and spectate from the side of the track – please arrive from 13:20.

Foundation stage Wednesday 17th May 13:00 – 15:00

The children will remain with their class teacher throughout the afternoon and they will move around different activities including running, throwing and jumping.
