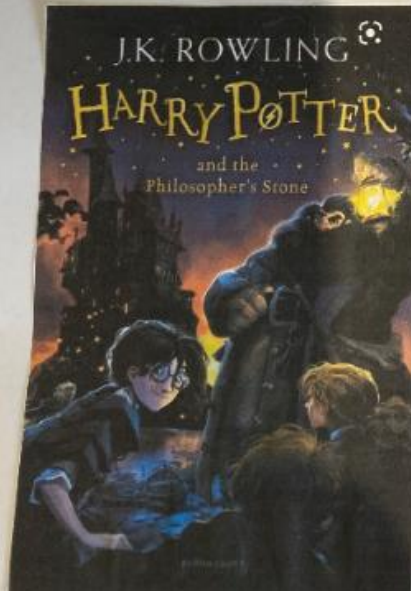


I recommend this book to children aged 8 years and over because it can be scary for little children.

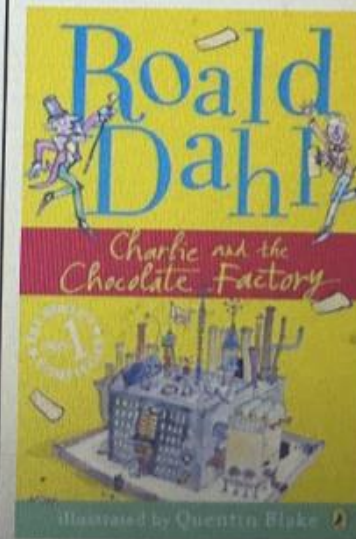

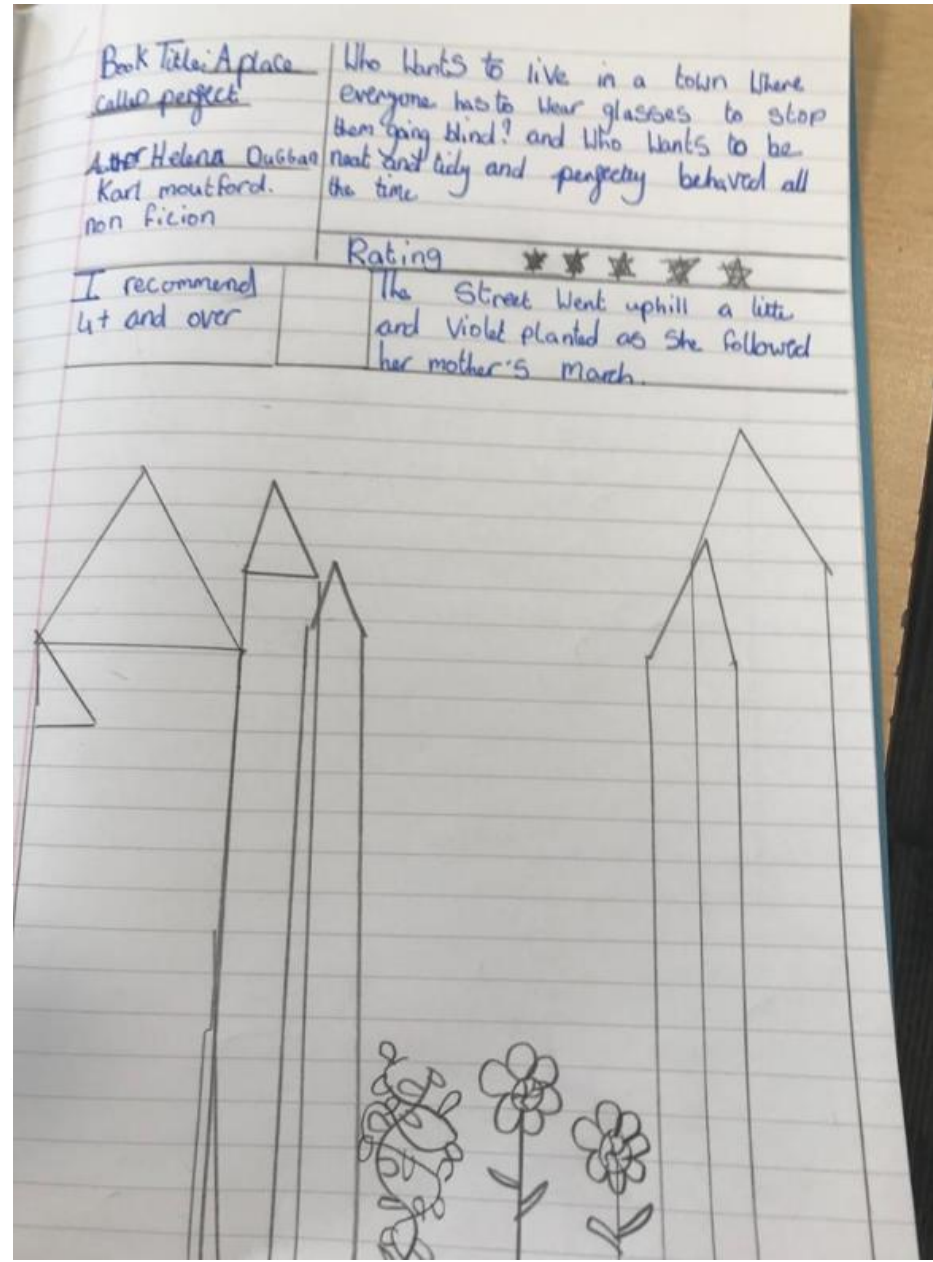
What is the book about?

Will Charlie succeed and be the overall winner?


