

Curriculum	Y1 Summer Term 1 Learning
English	<p style="text-align: center;">Writing</p> <p>Our writing for this half term will be based on recounting an event. We will be learning how to different shapes to represent different elements of our recount writing. We will learn how to use headings, sub headings, questions, events and a conclusion.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Reading</p> <p>We will be reading a variety of fiction and non-fiction texts. We will be using our different reading skills - prediction, retrieval and interpret - to answer a range of questions about the story. We will continue to work on our phonics this term.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Grammar</p> <p>This half term we will be learning about pronouns, suffixes and prepositions. We will continue to work on writing with different and more complex sentence structures.</p>
Mathematics	<p style="text-align: center;">Multiplication and Division</p> <p>In this unit we will be counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. Comparing equal and unequal groups. We will learn to look at how arrays can support our multiplication units.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Fractions</p> <p>In this unit we will learn to recognise half a shape or half of an amount, then quarter of a shape and an amount.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Position and direction</p> <p>We will learn to describe position and direction, we will learn about left and right, backwards and forwards and above and below.</p>
Science	<p style="text-align: center;">Plants</p> <p>In this unit we will be learning about identifying and naming a variety of common plants, including garden plants, wild plants and trees. We will look at those classified as deciduous and evergreen. We will learn and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including roots, stem/trunk, leaves and flower.</p>
Geography	<p style="text-align: center;">Mountains, Rivers and Coasts</p> <p>In this unit we will be looking mountains, rivers and coasts.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Fieldwork fortnight</p> <p>We will also be taking part in 'Fieldwork Fortnight' activities and taking a walk out into the local community to conduct surveys.</p>
PE	<p style="text-align: center;">Team Building</p> <p>In this unit we will learn to develop teamwork. Children will work individually, in pairs and in small groups, learning to take turns, work collaboratively and lead each other, This will support their development of communication and problem solving skills. Children will then be given the opportunity to discuss and plan their ideas and reflect on their successes.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Net and wall games</p> <p>In this unit we will begin with learning how to d return a ball with our hands and play against a partner. We will then go on to develop racket skills to return a ball.</p>
Computing	<p style="text-align: center;">Spreadsheets</p> <p>In this unit we will be learning how to use the 2Calculate tool on Purple Mash to help us make a counting machine. We will also use a spreadsheet for money calculations, check calculations and collect data to produce a graph.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Online Safety</p> <p>This half term we will learn how to keep ourselves safe when taking and sharing selfies.</p>
Art	<p style="text-align: center;">Stick Transformations</p> <p>In this unit we will be using our imaginations to transform a familiar object into a new form. We will be learning about Guatemalan worry dolls and transform sticks into our own worry dolls. Our artist for this unit is Chris Kenny</p>
RE	<p style="text-align: center;">Islam</p> <p>In this unit we will be learning about the importance of Hajj for Muslims</p>
Music	<p style="text-align: center;">Having fun with improvisation</p> <p>In this unit, we ask, 'What Songs Can We Sing to Help Us Through the Day?'. Childre are encouraged to be responsible and kind citizens of the world through their music learning. The children will learn to play instrument parts along with singing new songs.</p>
PSHCE	<p style="text-align: center;">Relationships</p> <p>In this unit we will learn about different relationships; including how families can be similar or different. We will discuss what makes a good friend. We will discuss different types of physical contact and their appropriateness. We will learn that everyone has the right to say no to things that make us uncomfortable.</p>
