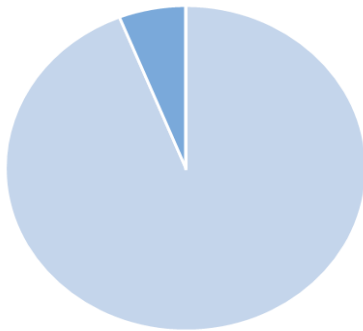
Date of survey – February 2021

123 parents responded to the survey.

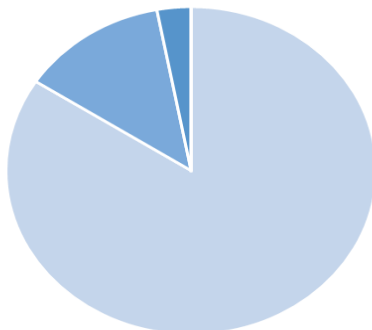
The blue charts are questions that were sent to the parents of children who are currently learning from home and the yellow/ orange charts were questions sent to all parents.

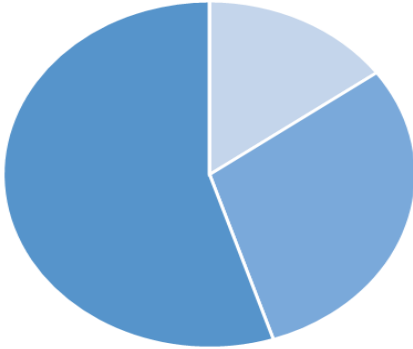
How frequently does your child receive feedback on their work?

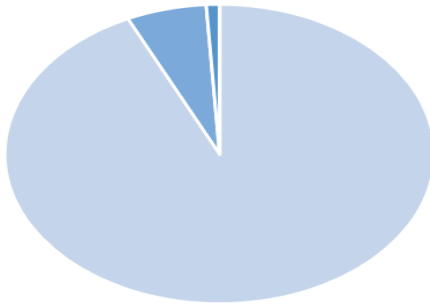


How often do technical issues disrupt your child's learning?



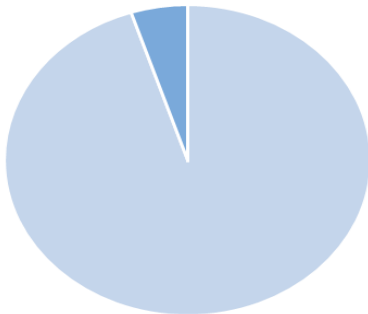

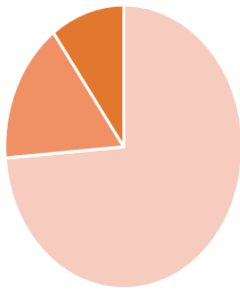

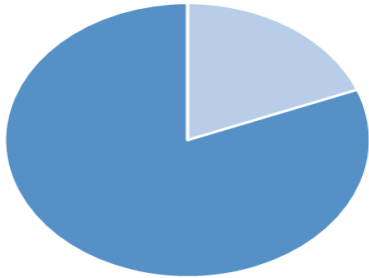


From your observations, how well is your child coping with the current situation?



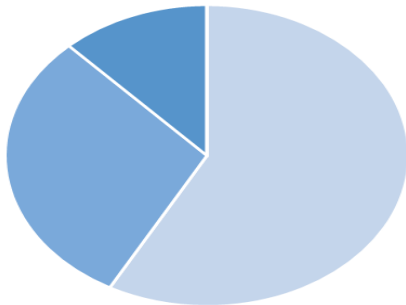

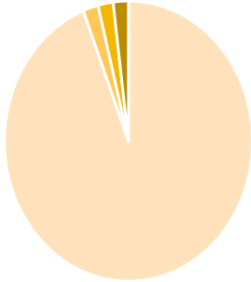
How well are you coping with your child learning from home?

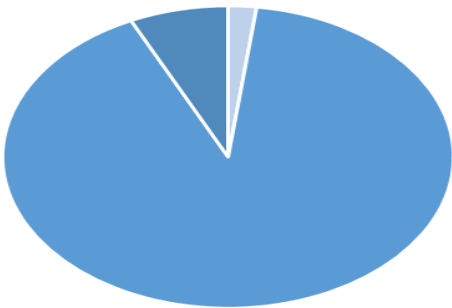


How clear has communication been during the current remote learning period?



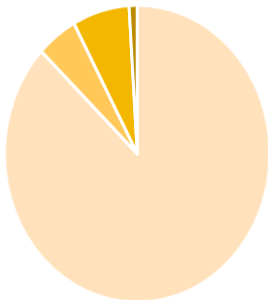

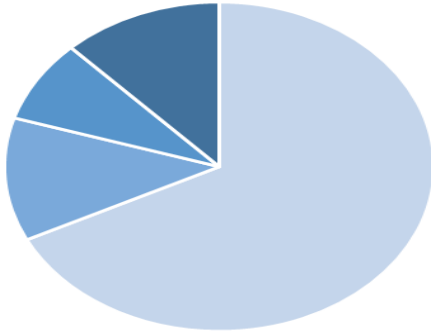
How easy or difficult is it to contact the school if needed?

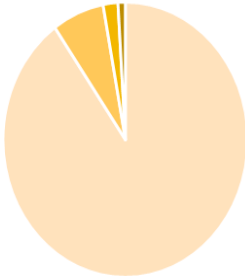


How easy or difficult is it to connect with individual teachers if you need to?

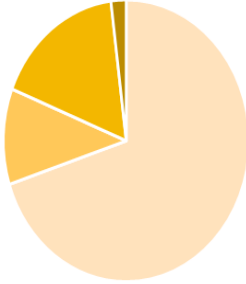
In general, how satisfied are you with collaboration with the school during this period?

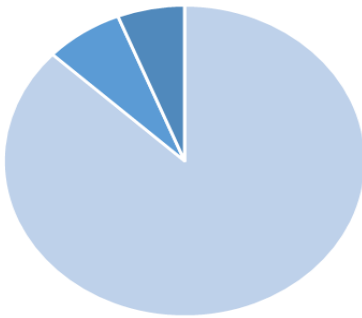


How much do you feel part of the school community at the moment?
