

Curriculum	Autumn 1 Learning
English	<p style="text-align: center;">Y3- Autumn is Here</p> <p>In this writing unit, children will explore language and features of poetry and write their own seasonal poem. Grammar will be woven throughout these lessons and our weekly grammar lesson will be linked to the learning in our writing lessons.</p> <p>During reading lessons, we will read and explore our reading skills of Explain, Retrieve, Interpret and Choice through the poem Fireplace by Ted Koosner.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Y4 - Still I Rise</p> <p>In this writing unit, children will explore language and features of poetry and write their own poem, following the structure of the poem studied.</p> <p>Grammar will be woven throughout these lessons and our weekly grammar lesson will be linked to the learning in our writing lessons.</p> <p>During reading lessons, we will read and explore our reading skills of Explain, Retrieve, Interpret and Choice through the poem Still I rise (edited version) by Maya Angelou.</p>
Mathematics	<p style="text-align: center;">Maths Y3</p> <p>Place value: children will learn how to represent, partition, estimate, compare and order numbers to 1000.</p> <p>Addition and Subtraction: children will use their place value knowledge to begin our addition and subtraction unit. Children will be learning to add and subtract 1s, 10, 100s.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Maths Y4</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Reasoning with 4-digit numbers</p> <p>In this unit the children will develop their understanding of the number system, identify 10,100,100 more or less than a given number and round numbers up to four digits with accuracy.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Addition and subtraction</p> <p>In this unit the children will develop appropriate strategies for addition and subtraction, practice the formal column addition and subtraction method and solve word problems.</p>
Science	<p style="text-align: center;">Animals and humans</p> <p>In this unit children will be taught that animals and humans need the right types and amount of nutrition, and that they cannot make their own food; they get nutrition from what they eat. Identify that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Sound</p> <p>Sound Children will understand how sounds are made and how they travel. Children will also learn the relationship between the features of the sound creator and the pitch and volume of the sound.</p>
Geography	<p style="text-align: center;">Using and Making Maps</p> <p>In this unit children will explore how to draw a map including landmarks, using simple symbols in a key.</p>

	<p>Children will learn how to locate key areas on a map, globe and digital computer mapping. Children will develop their map reading skills by naming the eight points of a compass and using six-figure grid references. stand for.</p> <p>UK Cities and Counties</p> <p>Children be able to recall the names of and locate at least eight counties in England. Children will be able to recall the names of and locate at least six cities in England.</p>
PE	<p>Y3- ball skills –outdoor Fundamental skills indoor Y4 –Netball – outdoor OAA</p>
Computing	<p>Coding <i>The children will learn how to explore, create and design computer programmes using algorithms.</i></p> <p>Online Safety <i>In this unit, children learn how to be webcam wise.</i></p>
RE	<p>Did Jesus Really Heal? In this unit, children will engage with a range of stories from the Bible where Jesus heals others and explore why this is important to Christians.</p>
Music	<p>Y3- I've been to Harlem Children will learn traditional pentatonic song about travelling around the world, full of creative possibilities. They will use it to invent cup rhythm games, explore pentatonic melodies from around the world, sing as a round, and compose ostinato accompaniments.</p> <p>Y4 We have the exciting opportunity to learn to play a musical instrument this term!</p>
