	Are there high expectations from our teachers for everyone in our classes? Are some children allowed to not do as much? Do our teachers expect
	high quality presentation from everyone in our classes?
	What has aspirations day taught us? Has aspirations day made a difference to us and how we think about our futures or not? What would make it
	even better?
11	Meeting – How are we finding our retrieval sessions in class? Do they happen every week? Do we have to write down the answers? What happens
