Mathematics	<p style="text-align: center;">Maths Y6</p> <p><i>Calculation problems: Understand the use of brackets; Use knowledge of the order of operations to carry out calculations; Generate and describe linear number sequences; Express missing number problems algebraically; Solve equations with unknown values</i></p> <p><i>Fractions: Deepen understanding of equivalence; Order, simplify and compare fractions, including those greater than one; Recall equivalence between common fractions and decimals; Find decimal quotients using short division; Add and subtract fractions; multiply and divide fractions and find fractions of amounts.</i></p>
Science	<p style="text-align: center;">Earth and Space</p> <p><i>In this unit, the children will learn about the sun and the moon and the solar system and how the Earth and moon are related to the sun. They will also learn about night and day; sunrise and sunset.</i></p>
