

Curriculum	Year 5 Spring 1 Learning
English	<p>Reading - The Unforgotten Coat by Frank Cottrell-Boyce The children will read this novel and practise reading comprehension skills.</p> <p>Writing – Refugees In this unit, the children will learn how to write a speech.</p> <p>Spelling and Grammar Children will use the sounds and syllables approach to practise spellings. Children will practise grammar skills which will support them in their writing.</p>
Maths	<p>Multiplication and Division Children will learn formal written methods for multiplication and division.</p> <p>Fractions Children will learn how to multiply fractions and find fractions of quantities and amounts.</p>
Science	<p>Light Children will learn how light travels, where it comes from and conduct experiments to prove this.</p>
History	<p>Anglo-Saxons In this unit, the children will learn about the life and battles of the Anglo Saxons in England until 1066.</p>
PE	<p>Gymnastics The children will practise and perform a sequence combining key aspects of gymnastics with control and poise.</p> <p>Basketball Children will learn how to travel with the ball, pass and intercept opposing teams.</p>
Computing	<p>Databases In this unit, children will learn how to search for information in a database, contribute to a class database and create a database around a chosen topic.</p>
Art	<p>Making Monotypes Children will learn that Monotype is a process where we make images by transferring ink from one surface to another to make a single print. That we can use the “distance” that monotype gives us between mark making and outcome to make images with texture and a sense of history/process. That we can combine monotype with other disciplines such as painting and collage.</p>
RE	<p>Hindu belief that there is one God with many different aspects. In this unit, children will explore Hindu beliefs regarding Brahma.</p>
Music	<p>Madina tun Nabi <i>Madina tun Nabi</i> is a catchy modern Nasheed (Islamic song) with a chorus in two parts. Pupils will learn to sing the song, develop their own accompaniment with a drone, chords, and improvisation, and play together with a percussion backing-track. On the way, they will be developing their ‘ear’ with lots of echo singing and playing by ear. They will find out about the type of song called a Nasheed and its connection with the Islamic faith.</p>
PSHE	<p>Dreams and Goals In this unit the children will learn how to set goals and steps for success, they will consider world problems - how to manage emotions about these and how they can work with others to make the world a better place, how to recognise the achievements of others.</p>
Languages (French)	<p>Les Planetes Children will use a language scaffold to make a statement about the position of planets in simple sentences using familiar and rehearsed language. Use a language scaffold to give a description (of a planet. Write more complex sentences to describe the position of planets using a language scaffold. Read and show understanding of a complex sentence using familiar language.</p>
