Dear Parents and Carers,

We have organised for our Year 5 children to take part in the Young Voices Concert at FLY DSL Arena on Thursday 2nd February 2023. Young Voices hold these massed choir events every year and we are very excited to take part for the twelfth time. There will be approximately 5,000 children all singing together.

Some details;

- There is no cost for the children to participate (the school has paid an entrance fee & will pay for the coach)
- The children will leave school about 12.30pm, and be practising for the afternoon.
- Children will need a pack-up for their tea and lots of water (No fizzy drinks please).
- The concert will begin at 7.00pm and finish at 9.15pm. We should return to school about 10.15pm.
- Parents and wider family can purchase tickets through school to watch the performance (£20 a ticket – no concessions). Please pay via parent pay. The closing date for ticket orders is Friday 3rd November.
- The children can buy (pre-order) an Official Young Voices T-shirt or wear a plain white T-shirt with school trousers / skirt. The T-shirts cost £12 for children sizes and £14.40 for adult sizes (please see attached order form when deciding which to buy for your child, you get a free tiny torch and wristband, lanyard and memory poster with every order, please note the size required and pay via parent pay. The closing date for T-shirt orders is Friday 3rd November.
- The deadline for adult tickets and T-shirts cannot be extended.
