WW2 Life.

More than 400,000 U.S. soldiers were killed in World war 2. Kids suffered the loss of their parents and siblings; parents grieved the loss of their children. Yet another gruesome statistic in the arithmetic of war is the number of soldiers missing in action, lost at sea, or interred as unknowns.

Over a million were evacuated from towns and cities and had to adjust to separation from family and friends. Many of those who stayed, endured bombing raids and were injured or made homeless. All had to deal with the threat of gas attacks, air raid precautions (ARP), rationing, changes at school and in their daily life.

While earlier wars also resulted in deaths of ^{about} civilians, civilians were particularly heavily affected by WW2 with about half of the WW2 European casualties being civilians. Among civilian deaths, between 9.8 and 10.4 million civilians were murdered for political or racial reasons by the Nazi regime (Auerbach 1992).

How fossils are formed

A fossil is formed when an animal dies and is covered by sediment very quickly.



Over billions of years the rock rises and is worn away by erosion.

Good places to find fossils are coastal or river sites with sizable cliffs.

Anyone can go fossil hunting and is a good way to get exercise and stay fit and healthy.

Over time the layers of sediment compacts and the muscle of the animal rots away leaving bone. More sediment covers it over time.

Water seeps into the bone and dissolves it leaving the minerals that form a mould in the rock.

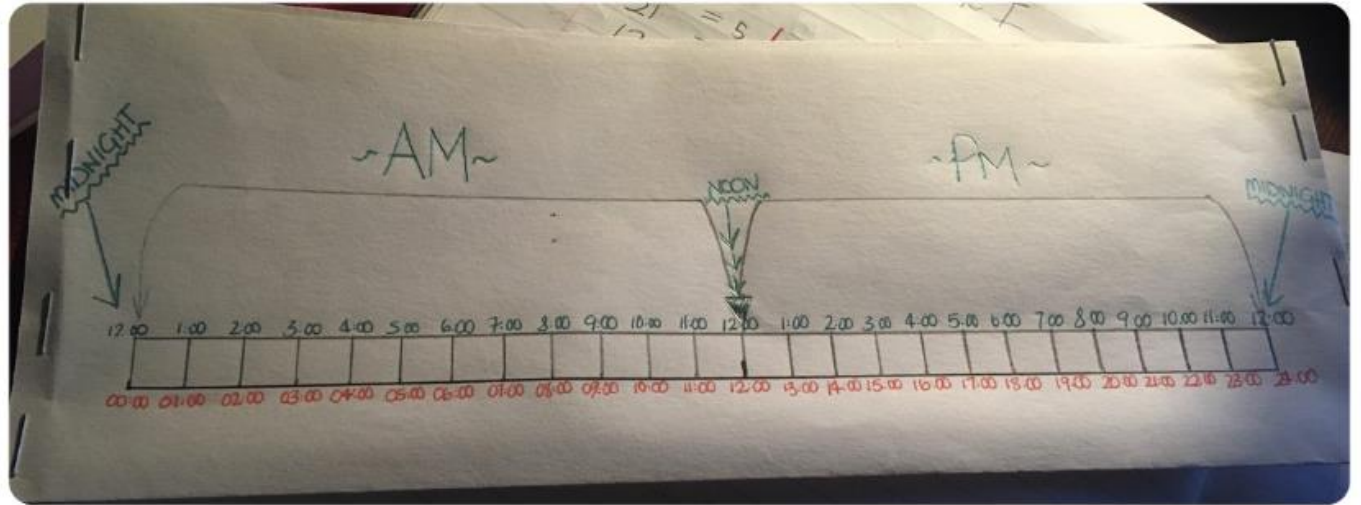

wooly mammoths had 4 large molars 2 on the top jaw and 2 on the

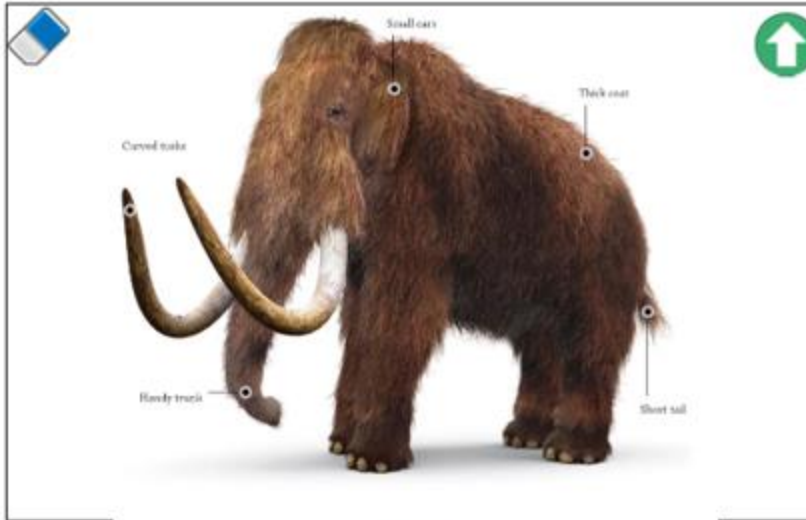
